2026 Fair Volunteer Information

Join our team of volunteers during the Fair! This is one of the most important ways the Foundation raises money to support preservation, education, and improvement initiatives that will ensure our fair continues to thrive for generations to come. Volunteers will receive FREE fair admission and a parking pass! Volunteering is a great way to make a difference and enjoy a free day at the Fair.

Organizations (businesses & civic clubs) are strongly encouraged to volunteer as a team. Volunteering as a team is a great way to represent your organization, build team spirit and reward your employees/members with a fun day at the Fair! Please note the following important guidelines:

- Volunteers may wear their business/organization logo apparel
- Volunteers may hand out business cards and/or brochures
- No signs, banners or other items may be affixed to the location/structure
- No promotional items (other than brochures or business cards) may be stored within the location/structure.

The Missouri State Fair Foundation offers several opportunities for donating time & talent:

1. **Bottled Water Sales**— Sell bottled water and Gatorade at one of our six outdoor gazebo locations. Duties include: serve as a Fair friendly ambassador, handle money (make change), re-stock as needed, work outside in a variety of weather conditions, and be able to alternate between sitting & standing for the duration of your scheduled shift.
2. **Souvenir Sales**— Sell Missouri State Fair official logo souvenirs and collectibles at the Souvenir Barn located near the entrance of the Midway or the Souvenir Trailer located in front of the Historic Administration Building. Duties include: serve as a Fair friendly ambassador, handle money (make change), operate the credit card machine, keep inventory tidy, in order, and re-stock as needed. You must be able to alternate between standing and sitting during your shift and work in an un-airconditioned environment.
3. **Scooter Rental**—Rent mobility scooters, wheelchairs, and strollers to the public. Duties include: greet and serve customers in a friendly manner, handle money, make change and operate the credit card machine, follow simple procedure to complete rental paperwork, and monitor inventory. Must be able to work under a tent in a variety of weather conditions and be able to alternate between standing and sitting during your shift.
4. **Museum Gift Shop** —Welcome visitors to the air-conditioned State Fair Museum & Gift Shop located in the lower level of the Woman's Building; sell souvenirs & collectibles. Hours of operation are 10 a.m.- 6 p.m. Shifts will run 10 - 2 and 2 - 6.

Volunteering is easy and fun! Simply complete and return the attached form. Volunteers are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. However, scheduling preference is given to MSF Foundation members and those who volunteer for more than one shift. After we receive your form, we will contact you to confirm your volunteer schedule.
